HOLIDAY DECORATIONS


A reminder that all Christmas decorations need to be removed by January 15th. Please adhere to this guidelines to avoid a violation. We thank you in advance for your cooperation.

WINDOWS IN COMMUNITY

If you are the <u>original</u> owner and you have noticed windows in your home with broken seals you may want to contact Milgard Windows. BULK ITEM TRASH PICK UP

Please remember that if you have large items for pick up by Waste Management that you need to call to arrange for a bulk pick up. (866) 238-3301. Once arrangements have been made you may place your bulk items at the curb <u>24 hours</u> prior to pick up following the same guidelines as the trash cans. Please note that Waste Management will not pick up any items that are not in the trash cans unless you have requested a bulk pick up. And if you are putting out items such as a refrigerator, please ensure the door is either off or is secure. Thank you for your cooperation.

COMMUNITY DISTRICTS

Did you know that we have three separate districts within our community? The names of those districts are Galway, which are townhouses east of Mashona; Fostoria, which are single family homes that are west of Mashona and east of Zivi, and Lalique, which are also single family homes that are west of Zivi. Each of these districts are unique, Galway, although a part of the master community, has its own Board of Directors and since Galway is made up of townhouses all their exterior maintenance, including landscaping, is performed by the association. Fostoria owners are responsible for all exterior maintenance to their homes but their front landscaping is done by the association and as such they aren't able to alter their front landscaping. Lalique owners are also responsible for all maintenance to the exterior of their homes but their landscaping is their personal responsibility; it is not done by the association. That is why you will see color and different types of landscaping in the Lalique district.
