Shores Home Painting & Wrought Iron Fencing Repair Schedules

As earlier published in our July issue last year by Tom Moore, Chairperson of the Shores Paint Committee, the following is a recap of the painting calendar/schedule for the Shores homes by street, which resumes this year following the 1-year "hold" on the painting schedule to conserve budgetary levels due to the extensive roof repair expenses experienced.

Painting will resume in March. The following list is when you should expect your house to be painted:

- 2021 Via Murcia
- 2022 Via Apolina
- 2023 Via Morena

- 2024 Via Rene
- 2025 Via Maria and Via Oporto
- 2026 Via Fonte
- 2027 Via Andalusia

Approved Vista Paint colors for "The Shores" can be viewed in the color book located at the clubhouse. Another opportunity for selecting your color plan is looking around the lake for a color that you like too. If this is the method you select, simply call Tom with the address of the home you've identified and he can advise the name of the color.

Color options have changed in the past 8 years. Many homeowners like their existing color and want everything the same. Not all colors available 8 years ago are still available – so checking the paint book or looking at more recently painted houses is strongly encouraged.

A letter will also be sent to Via Murcia homeowners to encourage them to make any repairs, preparation and color selections prior to a mid-to-late March start on this year's painting. If you need help finding the most experienced contractors familiar with typical dry-rot, exterior termite or other damage to our Shores residential home's exterior woodwork, you may also call Tom Moore at (714) 695-9410.

- 2026 Via Fonte and Via Morena
- 2027 Via Andalusia and Via Rene

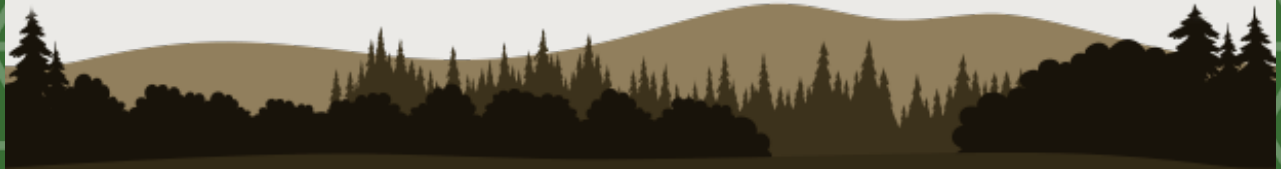
