TURF

Mowing – Mowing height will be at 1.5” and will remain at the height for the winter.

Fertilization – The first fertilization to turf will be completed after the first mowing.

Herbicide – No herbicide applications are scheduled for December. Planter areas will be treated with Glyphosate as needed.



SHRUBS

Focus Pruning – Maintenance pruning will continue as needed. Structure of shrubs will be kept looking natural without balling or squaring the shape.

Plant Replacement – Plant replacements will occur based on approved service order requests.



TREES

Scheduled Trimming – Tree pruning will be completed in December.

DECEMBER 2019 HIGHLIGHTS

Notes:

* December brings the possibility of nighttime freezing temperatures. Plant growth has slowed. Irrigation should be reduced to minimum levels.

The winter rye lawns should now be established. Fertilize to maintain color and vigor. Ice may be present in the mornings. Do not walk or drive on lawns where ice is present, or you will kill the grass.

Frost can burn susceptible shrubs and flowers. Limit pruning on these susceptible plants for the next couple of months. Consider covering valuable plants when possible during extreme cold. Avoid planting sensitive plants. Young plants tend to be more susceptible to frost damage.
