TURF

Mowing – Irrigation timers will be increased to encourage Bermuda growth.

Fertilization – No fertilization scheduled for the month of June.

Herbicide – Spot spraying for nutsedge with monument will continue



SHRUBS

Focus Pruning – Avoid any heavy pruning to prevent sun damage to plants.

Plant Replacement – No plant replacement is scheduled for June. Plant replacements will only be done per work order on special request.



TREES

Scheduled Trimming – Palm trees will be pruned in June/July.

JUNE 2019 HIGHLIGHTS

Summer has arrived. Stress on plants and landscape workers will be extreme for the next 3 months. Adequate irrigation is critical to limit plant stress.

Pruning should be selective to those plants that can tolerate summer heat. Heavy pruning should be avoided if possible.

New plantings should be limited. If there are new plantings, they may require additional care until established.

Annual flowers need to be watched closely for signs of stress or pests.

Washingtonia palms should be ready to prune this month.

In turf areas remaining ryegrass will be dying, and extra care should be given to areas with poor Bermuda coverage. Increasing irrigation, fertilizing, aerating, seeding or soding may be necessary.
