TURF

Mowing – Turf was lowered in April to encourage Bermuda transition.

Fertilization – Fertilizer was applied in April. No fertilization scheduled for May.

Herbicide – Spot spraying of broadleaf weeds with Herbicides will continue.



SHRUBS

Focus Pruning – Conducting seasonal pruning if applicable.

Plant Replacement – Plant replacement has been done per work order or special request.



TREES

Scheduled Trimming – Pruning will be completed in May.

MAY 2019 HIGHLIGHTS

May brings the possibility of summer temperatures to the desert. By the middle of May temperatures are in the 90's and often exceed 100 degrees.

Monitor the weather closely and increase irrigation as necessary

Turf areas may look bad as ryegrass transitions into Bermuda. Fertilize to help with this transition.

Continue to prune shrubs to keep them under control.

Any remaining winter annuals will be declining rapidly and should be removed. Summer annuals should be planted this month. Water frequently to establish these young tender plants.

Date palms should be pruned this month before the dates develop.
