TURF



Mowing – Mowing height is currently at 1.5” and will remain at this height for the winter season.

Fertilization – An application of Calcium Nitrate was applied in December. No scheduled applications for January.

Herbicide – Broadleaf weeds will be spot sprayed with herbicide.

SHRUBS



Focus Pruning – Only light maintenance pruning will be completed due to the cold weather. Weeds in shrub beds will continue to be sprayed.

Plant Replacement – Plant replacements for the month of January will be done per service order request.

TREES



Scheduled Trimming – No tree pruning is scheduled this month.

JANUARY 2020 HIGHLIGHTS

Notes: January is the coldest month of the year. There is usually a chance of frost and ice may be present on turf areas.

Limit heavy pruning of shrubs. Do not walk or drive on turf areas when ice is present.

Foliage on shrubs that are damaged by frost should not be removed until the chance of frost is over. Removing the damaged foliage prematurely could result in further damage to these plants.

Fertilize turf to maintain color and vigor. Fertilizer should be limited on shrubs and flowers to prevent new growth that is susceptible to frost damage.

If possible, delay planting frost sensitive plants until the weather warms up.

Flower beds may not dry out especially if there is significant rain. Monitor flowers for signs of fungus and treat if necessary.

Irrigation will be at the lowest levels of the year.
