TURF

Mowing – Turf was lowered in April to encourage Bermuda transition.

Fertilization – Fertilizer was applied in April. No fertilization scheduled for May.

Herbicide – Spot spraying of broadleaf weeds with Herbicides will continue.



SHRUBS

Focus Pruning – Conducting seasonal pruning if applicable.

Plant Replacement – Plant replacement will be done per work order or special requests.



TREES

Scheduled Trimming – Pruning will be completed in May.

MAY 2020 HIGHLIGHTS

Notes:

May usually brings the first 100-degree temperatures. As the weather heats up, annual flowers will begin to decline. Rye grass will also begin to decline. Check irrigation and increase run times anticipating the high temperatures to come.

This month is the last chance to perform heavy pruning of shrubs. Heat sensitive plants should have limited pruning after this month.

Date Palms should be pruned this month into early June before fruit matures.

Winter annual flowers should be removed, and summer annuals should be planted.

Turf areas should be fertilized to help transition to summer Bermuda Turf.
