TURF

Mowing – Turf will be lowered to encourage Bermuda transition.

Fertilization – Fertilizer will be applied at the end of the month in April.

Herbicide – Spot spraying of broadleaf weeds with Herbicides will continue.



SHRUBS

Focus Pruning – Expect heavier seasonal pruning if applicable since this is an optimal time for rapid and excessive growth.

Plant Replacement – Plant replacement has been done per work order or special request.



TREES

Scheduled Trimming – Pruning is scheduled for the month of April.

APRIL 2018 HIGHLIGHTS

April is a good month for landscapes in the desert. The temperatures continue to be mild.

This month continues to be a good time for corrective or heavy pruning. Pruning now allows the plants to recover before the extreme heat of summer.

April is still a good time to plant new plants in the landscape.

Winter annual flowers may begin to decline especially as temperatures exceed 90 degrees. Dead head flowers regularly and remove plants as they die.

Continue to watch for pests on new growth. Treat agaves to prevent weevil damage.

Fertilize Bermuda grass to encourage growth anticipating transition next month.

Continue to increase irrigation as the temperatures increase.
