TURF

Mowing – Mowing height will remain the same until the over-seeding process begins.

Fertilization – No fertilization is scheduled for the month of August.

Herbicide – Monument application to treat for nutsedge will be completed in August.



SHRUBS

Focus Pruning – Normal maintenance pruning will be our focus and the avoidance of pruning heat sensitive shrubs.

Plant Replacement – Plant replacements will be done on a per work order basis with managers approval.



TREES

Scheduled Trimming – Palm pruning was completed in July. No pruning scheduled or August.

AUGUST 2018 HIGHLIGHTS

The hot summer weather experienced in July will continue thru August. Humidity usually increases and makes working conditions difficult for landscape workers.

Adequate irrigation remains critical. Monitor for stressed plants or turf and adjust irrigation as necessary.

Continue to limit heavy pruning especially on heat sensitive plants. Foliage that is burned should not be removed until next month. Spray weeds that appear in shrub beds.

Special attention should be given to any turf areas that have not filled in. Bermuda does not grow well in shade areas so expect to see poor quality turf under trees, near walls, or between buildings. Continue to treat nut sedge and broadleaf weeds if necessary.

Annual flowers may begin to decline this month. Remove spent plants and monitor for pests or disease.
