



Indian Palms C.C. - HOA December 2016 Landscape Report

Turf:

- *Mowing Height:*

Mowing height will be at 1.5" and will remain at the height for the winter.

- *Fertilization:*

The first fertilization to turf will be completed after the first mowing.

- *Herbicide Applications:*

No herbicide applications are scheduled for December. Planter areas will be treated with Glyphosate that show germination of rogue ryegrass as needed.

Shrubs:

- *Focus Pruning:*

Maintenance pruning will continue as needed. Structure of shrubs will be kept looking natural without balling or squaring the shape.

- *Pesticide Applications:*

Volunteer ryegrass along with emerged weeds will be sprayed in the open areas.

- *Plant Replacement:*

Plant replacements will occur based on approved service order requests.

Trees:

- Tree pruning will be completed in December.

Irrigation:

- Our target for winter rye will be the new "Efficient" budget which is 25% lower than the old budget. However, our priority is to maintain healthy green grass and we will increase water as needed.
