



Indian Palms C.C. - HOA
July 2016 Landscape Report

Turf:

- *Mowing Height:*
Mowing height will remain at 1" until the overseeding process begins.
- *Fertilization:*
Fertilizer treatments will be made if necessary.
- *Herbicide Applications:*
Spot spraying for nutsedge will take place in the month of July.

Shrubs:

- *Focus Pruning:*
Normal maintenance pruning will be our primary focus with an emphasis on lantana and bougainvillea.
- *Pesticide Applications:*
Spraying of weeds in shrub beds will continue throughout the month with routine gardening.
- *Plant Replacement:*
No scheduled plant replacements for July. Service order plant replacements will continue as they come in.

Trees:

Palm tree pruning will continue into July until completed.

Irrigation Schedules:

Effective June 21, IWA has removed the water day restrictions which now allows for outdoor watering seven days a week. The Drought Penalty surcharge will remain in effect but this is below the ET requirements for green turf. Our current watering times are 24 min for hunter heads and 12 min for the pop-up irrigation daily. This is in keeping with the drought budget. If the HOA or homeowners would like increased irrigation times we request written confirmation which may go over your IWA water budget.
