TURF

Mowing – Height will remain the same for the rest of the season.

Fertilization – Fertilization will only be applied on selective areas affected by street slurry.

Herbicide – Spot spraying for nutsedge will continue in July.



SHRUBS

Focus Pruning – Heavy pruning will be avoided to prevent sun damage.

Plant Replacement – Replacements will be done per work order or special request.



TREES

Scheduled Trimming – All Palm pruning was completed last month in June.

JULY 2018 HIGHLIGHTS

July is usually the hottest month of the summer. The priority is keeping the landscape alive until cooler weather. Irrigation is critical and takes constant monitoring. July is not the month to try and save water.

Even with adequate water many plants can stress and burn during the extreme consistent heat in July. Limit shrub pruning as much as possible especially on heat sensitive plants. Hold off on fertilizer until the weather cools. Prune any palms that were not pruned in June.

Monitor for pests and disease on annual flowers.

Bermuda should be filled in by now. Fertilize any areas that are weak. Treat for nutsedge where necessary.
