

## Indian Palms HOA

### TURF



**Mowing** – Irrigation timer adjusted accordingly to encourage Bermuda.

**Fertilization** – No fertilization scheduled for the month of June.

**Herbicide** – Spot spraying for nutsedge with monument will continue.

### SHRUBS



**Focus Pruning** – Avoid any hand pruning to prevent sun damage to plants.

**Plant Replacement** – No plant replacement is scheduled for June. Plant replacements will only be done per work order on special request.

### TREES



**Scheduled Trimming** – Palm trees should be pruned in June/July.

### JUNE 2017 HIGHLIGHTS

Summer annuals have just been planted and adequate irrigation is critical for establishment. Monitor new plants for pest and disease.

Remaining Rye grass will be dying off. Treat turf for nutsedge or broadleaf weeds that appear.

Reduce severity of shrub pruning to prevent damage during hot summer months.

Control weeds in shrub beds.

Increase irrigation as temperatures rise.

Prune palms in June and July.

Protect valuable sensitive plants from sun damage.
