### JUNE 2018 HIGHLIGHTS



#### TURF

**Mowing** – Irrigation timers will be adjusted accordingly to encourage Bermuda growth.

**Fertilization** – No fertilization scheduled for the month of June.

**Herbicide** – Spot spraying for nutsedge with monument will continue.



#### SHRUBS

**Focus Pruning** – Avoid any heavy pruning to prevent sun damage to plants.

**Plant Replacement** – No plant replacement is scheduled for June. Plant replacements will only be done per work order on special request.



#### TREES

**Scheduled Trimming** – Palm trees should be pruned in June/July.

June brings on the summer heat. Last June we had multiple days near 120 degrees.

Adequate irrigation becomes critical at these high temperatures. Increase irrigation as needed and monitor daily for deficiencies.

Prune shrubs to control growth but avoid excessive foliage removal or plants may burn. Heat sensitive plants may burn in high temperatures.

Apply herbicides to control weeds in turf and planter beds. Monitor annual flowers for pest problems and treat as necessary.

Mowing heights should be lowered to promote good quality summer Bermuda turf.

June is a good time to plant or transplant palms.
