TURF

Mowing – Expect rapid growth.

Fertilization – Fertilizer with pre-emergent barricade applied last month.

Herbicide – Spot spraying of broadleaf weeds with Herbicides will continue.



SHRUBS

Focus Pruning – Expect heavier seasonal pruning if applicable since this is an optimal time for rapid and excessive growth.

Plant Replacement – Plant replacement has been done per work order or special request.



TREES

Scheduled Trimming – No pruning is scheduled for the month of March.

MARCH 2017 HIGHLIGHTS

The warm mild weather of March promotes rapid and excessive growth of plants. Insect/pest problems are also increased at this time. Watering needs increase for all plants as temperatures rise. Now that the threat of frost is over any dead wood or undesirable foliage will be pruned.

Note: Day time watering will take place only to check irrigation coverage after repairs are completed.

SPRING FORWARD, FALL BACK

Daylight Saving Time: Begins the second Sunday of March (12th) and reverts to standard time on the first Sunday of November (5th). During DST, clocks are turned forward an hour, effectively moving an hour of morning to the evening. At the start of spring (March 20, 2017) the spring equinox – day and night are approximately 12 hours long and the Sun is at the midpoint of the sky.
