TURF

Mowing – Expect rapid growth.

Fertilization – Fertilizer with pre-emergent barricade applied last month.

Herbicide – Spot spraying of broadleaf weeds with Herbicides will continue.



SHRUBS

Focus Pruning – Expect heavier seasonal pruning if applicable since this is an optimal time for rapid and excessive growth.

Plant Replacement – Plant replacement has been done per work order or special request.



TREES

Scheduled Trimming – No pruning scheduled for the month of March.

MARCH 2018 HIGHLIGHTS

March brings consistent warm weather to the Coachella Valley. The chance of frost is over and with the warm weather comes rapid growth in trees shrubs and turf.

Now is the best time to perform corrective heavy pruning if necessary. Plants recover quickly and can regrow before the onset of the extreme heat of summer.

This month is the best time to plant new shrubs in the landscape.

Watch for plant pests feeding on new growth and treat when necessary. Spray or remove weeds when they emerge to prevent establishment and reseeding.

Fertilize all plants in the landscape. Manage fertility on turf to prevent excessive growth.

Olives can continue to be sprayed to prevent fruit until flowering is completed.

Irrigation will need to be increased as the weather continues to warm up.

SPRING FORWARD, FALL BACK

Daylight Saving Time: Begins the second Sunday of March (11th) and reverts to standard time on the first Sunday of November (4th). During DST, clocks are turned forward an hour.
