TURF

Mowing – Turf was lowered in April to encourage Bermuda transition.

Fertilization – Fertilizer was applied in April. No fertilization scheduled for May.

Herbicide – Spot spraying of broadleaf weeds with Herbicides will continue.



SHRUBS

Focus Pruning – Conducting seasonal pruning if applicable.

Plant Replacement – Plant replacement has been done per work order or special request.



TREES

Scheduled Trimming – Pruning was completed in April. No pruning scheduled for May.

MAY 2018 HIGHLIGHTS

May is the month of transition and the last chance to complete landscape tasks before the extreme heat of summer.

Annual winter flowers that remain will need to be removed. If summer annuals are to be planted, the sooner they are installed the better so that they have some time to establish before the heat of June.

Dry spots in turf areas can be expected as ryegrass dies out and the lawns transition to Bermuda. Fertilize to promote vigorous growth of Bermuda to facilitate transition.

May is the last chance to prune heat sensitive shrubs.

This month is also the last chance for planting heat sensitive plants.

Irrigation times will need to be increased as temperatures rise.
