TURF

Mowing – Lowering height gradually to help Bermuda dormancy.

Fertilization – Not scheduled for this month.

Herbicide – Not scheduled for this month.



SHRUBS

Focus Pruning – Removing dead plant material damaged by the summer heat.

Plant Replacement – Replacement will be done per walkthrough or work order.



TREES

Scheduled Trimming – No scheduled tree pruning for the month of September.



SEPTEMBER 2017 HIGHLIGHTS

September brings some relief to desert landscapes. Temperatures begin to fall and days shorten. Sunburnt and dead materials on shrubs can be removed. Heat sensitive plants can now be pruned. Heavy pruning can now be completed if necessary.

September is a good time for plant replacement shrubs or new landscapes.

It's time to remove annual flowers and begin to prepare beds for fall planting.

Irrigation should be reduced in turf areas to slow growth in preparation for overseeding. Turf may be slowly reduced in height.

Irrigation run time will be reduced as weather cools.

Notes:

*High temperatures are not only dangerous to plants but also for people. In temperatures over 110 degrees work will slow down **at 115 degrees work is stopped for the safety of landscape workers.**
