TURF

Mowing – Lowering height gradually to begin overseeding process

Fertilization – Not scheduled for this month.

Herbicide – Not scheduled for this month.



SHRUBS

Focus Pruning – Removing dead plant material damaged by the summer heat.

Plant Replacement – Replacement will be done per walkthrough or work order.



TREES

Scheduled Trimming – Tree pruning will begin this month if approved



SEPTEMBER 2018 HIGHLIGHTS

September brings an end to the intense heat of summer. Days shorten and temperatures may drop below 100 degrees. Reduce irrigation as temperatures drop.

Mid-September begins the fall planting season. This is a good time for tree and shrub planting or replacement.

Heat sensitive plants may begin to recover from summer damage. Mid-September is a good time to remove sun burn damaged foliage. This is a good time to perform any heavy pruning that may be necessary. Fertilize trees and shrubs to help with recovery.

Gradually begin to reduce irrigation in turf areas in preparation for overseeding. Begin to reduce mowing heights 3 weeks before applying rye seed.

Remove any remaining annual flowers and begin to prep beds for fall color.
