

## Approved Paint Color Information & Guidelines

The Dunn-Edwards paint palette colors shown [online](#) are for reference purposes only. Computer monitors and printers vary in their representation of colors, so **be sure to verify your selections with paint chips.**

You may request paint chips online or pick them up at Dunn-Edwards Paints, 79 Via Pico Plaza, San Clemente, CA 92672 (949) 272-3689. Dunn Edwards can also overlay a photo of your home with the selected colors to help verify the look. Make an appointment at the store for this service.

Pacific Shores has adopted 16 color schemes. The schemes may not be altered, switched, or mixed & matched. Once you choose a scheme, **you must submit an architectural request form** for final approval.

Here are the options/guidelines/directions for the use of our schemes:

- 1) **No paint color substitutions allowed.** The scheme's *Main Stucco Body* color must be used on the body of the house and *Trim* color must be used on the trim. For the **architectural pop-out features** (around some windows and doors) you may use **either** the *Main Stucco Body* color or the *Stucco Accent* color. The *Stucco Accent* color will highlight the pop-outs.
- 2) **Wood Garage doors** and those that have been previously painted are to be painted the designated *Garage Door* color from your scheme. (Homeowners do not need to paint factory-painted metal doors. Instead, choose a scheme that compliments your garage door color.)
- 3) **Front doors** may be painted the *Entry Door* color designated in the scheme **or** a color from the list of *Alternate Door Options* at the end of the color ark may be requested. \*Stained wood doors do **not** have to be painted.
- 4) **\*Please note:** Adjacent homes are prohibited from having the same color scheme. Please choose an alternate scheme to that of your next-door neighbors.
