ARCHITECTURAL SUBMITTAL AND APPROVAL

Please remember that <u>all</u> home improvements, including a new garage door, new windows, replacing concrete, replacing a gate, painting of your home, or landscape replacement requires the approval of *both* the Pacific Shores Architectural Committee and the RSC Master Architectural Committee prior to the start of any work. This is in accordance with the Association's governing documents.

Failure to submit an architectural application could result in a Hearing with the Board of Directors, where a fine may be assessed to your account.

Architectural applications can be found on the Pacific Shores website at www.pacific-shores.org. Please complete and submit with all attachments and photos either to your Seabreeze representative, Lydia McCaig, or to the Pacific Shores ARC to start the review process. Plan accordingly! As outlined in your governing documents, the entire review process of both the sub-association and the Master may last between 60-90 days.

COMMUNITY REMINDER — ASSOCIATION LANDSCAPE

Previously, the August newsletter addressed the Association common area slope clearing, being performed by the Association's contracted vendor, Medlin Landscape.

Slope trimming has been ordered at the direction of the Orange County Fire Authority. The Board of Directors and the Landscape Committee have authorized the heavy pruning of the common area plant material, which is heavily overgrown.

It's been noted that some common area slopes, which are maintained by the Association, contain plant material installed by homeowners, which is not permitted under regulation of the OCFA. Plants such as avocado trees, vegetables, and cactus/succulents have been found to be planted in the slopes outside of private fences and yards. Please note that these items will be asked to be removed and placed in your private yard.

The landscape crew is working their way through the community and anticipate completion by end of 2017.
