#### **BUDGET COMMITTEE MEMBER**

#### SHEET METAL REPAIR UPDATE

The Board is currently interviewing project managers for the sheet metal repairs. Once the project manager is determined by the board of directors, the scope of work for repairs will be created and bid to three independent contractors. Management has received several reports of an increase of rodents seen in the community. The association continues to have a certified pest control company monitor and refill the bait stations throughout the community monthly. Reports of coyote and rattlesnake sightings have also been reported. A resident advised Management that her small dog was bit by a rattlesnake within their backyard.

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A few ways to keep rodents and coyotes away is to keep your trash containers closed tightly and do not leave pet food outside on any length of time.
