SHEET METAL REPAIR UPDATE

SPEEDING WITHIN THE COMMUNITY

Speeding within the community continues to be a serious issue and the traffic signs are not being abided by. Please be aware the speed limit within the community is 15mph and ALL stop signs should be abided by and stopped at.

PICK UP AFTER YOUR PETS

It seems there is an increasing issue of residents failing to pick up after their dogs. This is in direct violation of OCCO 4-1-50 Curbing Your Pets and the community's rules. Moreover, this failure to pick up after your dogs is disrespectful to your neighbors and community. Residents who are caught in the act will be called before the Board and assessed potential fines according to the fine policy of the community. Do your part to keep this community looking its best!

RODENTS & COYOTES!

Management has received several reports of an increase of rodents seen in the community. The association continues to have a certified pest control company monitor and refill the bait stations throughout the community monthly. Reports of coyote and rattlesnake sightings have also been reported. A resident advised Management that her small dog was bit by a rattlesnake within their backyard.

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A few ways to keep rodents and coyotes away is to keep your trash containers closed tightly and do not leave pet food outside on any length of time.
