FIRE SPRINKLER TESTING

The fire sprinkler testing is underway, if you have a conflict with your scheduled day, please do not wait to contact StoneKastle Community Management. A back-up date has been set for May 20, 2016. We realize this project is an inconvenience; however it is a mandatory test that must be done this year. The entire community must be inspected before the report can be submitted to the appropriate authorities. Therefore your cooperation is sincerely appreciated and needed.

Please note that the company doing the testing will charge additional money to come out and reinspect any homes that were not included in the initial round. Therefore, to avoid the potential of incurring those charges, please kindly be as helpful and cooperative as you can.

A schedule was sent to everyone in the community with your inspection date. If you cannot locate your schedule, copies are posted at the mailboxes.

Perimeter Tree Removals

If there is a tree behind your home on the perimeter of the San Lorenzo property (located between the golf course cart path and the slope behind your back yard fence) and you would like to request a removal, please contact taryn@stonekaslte.com. There is an application that you'll need to complete.

As the process to have these tree(s) approved to be removed by the City of Yorba Linda is very lengthy, the requests are only made periodically. Therefore, to ensure that any and all requests for tree removals are submitted so the City as needed, please fill out the application, (if you're interested) promptly so all requests can be handled at one time, as required by the city and the golf course.

Earthquake Coverage - June Meeting Town Hall

Currently, our community is not covered by earthquake insurance and so the board feels an obligation to help educate the community in an effort to determine if purchasing earthquake insurance for the community is something we should do.

All owners are invited to attend our monthly meeting, next scheduled for June 13, 2016 at 7 PM. Please bring your questions. Additional information will continue to be provided; Mike Rey, Farmers Insurance will be in attendance at the June meeting to discuss any earthquake related questions you have. Differing levels of coverage may be available but, as an example, one of the current earthquake coverage options Mike discussed at our last Town Hall, was coverage for the community in the amount of \$10 million. As an example, coverage for that amount, for San Lorenzo would potentially cost each homeowner \$22.00/month.

Therefore please make sure you remove any personal property you may have placed in the closets on or before June 1, 2016 as management reserves the right to remove any personal property and dispose of those items after that date.
