Trash in Common Areas

Please be reminded to pick-up and dispose of properly any trash when leaving the pool area, tennis court, or greenbelt areas.

If you see anyone from the apartments across the alley dumping old furniture behind the Stonegate garages or in the alley please remind them to call Republic Trash and not make it someone else's problem. Republic Trash can be reached at (714) 238-3300.

Just a reminder to pick up after your pets when walking them in the community. Be courteous to your neighbors.

Miscellaneous

- **1.** With all the rain recently please be sure you are clearing your rain gutters and keeping an eye on your drains to prevent any flooding.
- 2. The Board approved for the pool and jacuzzi to be acid washed in the next few weeks. This involves draining all the water out of both areas, acid washing and then re-filling the pool and jacuzzi back with water. When this occurs, the pool and Jacuzzi will be closed off for this process.
- **3.** Recently there have been some folks working on cars in the alleyways, changing oil and rotating tires. This is not allowed at the Stonegate Association. If you witness this please call DPA Security to have the vehicles cited or towed.
- **4.** For those of you needing the paint color for new garage doors it is Dunn Edwards Big Stone Beach DE 6132 Flat Sheen.
- **5.** Stonegate Association is a Neighborhood Watch Community and it takes everyone looking out for everyone's safety and compliance of the Association Rules.

Parking

Parking in front of closed garages is common and is against Stonegate's CC&Rs. If you or your guest does park in front of your garage, we do require that garages be open, and that you are within earshot. This parking is only allowed for a short period of time, like unloading your car. A violation can be posted to the car and multiple violations can result in your car being towed away, at your expense. Just a reminder the parking placards costs \$100.00. Once payment is received for the placard, the patrol company, DPA Security, will contact you and provide the placard.

DPA Security is your parking patrol company. If there is a safety issue or major disturbance in the community the Garden Grove Police should be called directly, not the patrol company. Recently there have been transients going thru the trash cans. Do not confront them but you can call the Garden Grove Police Dept. to remove them out of the association. If you need to safelist your vehicle call DPA Security only.

Clubhouse Rental

Reminder - The Association's clubhouse is available for private use by the residents of Stonegate. If you are interested in renting the clubhouse, please contact Cardinal at 714-779-1300. Also be reminded that bounce houses set up in common areas and piñatas attached to common area trees are not permitted at any time.
