



TURF

Mowing: As the Bermuda slows down and goes dormant, mowing will be completed as needed.

Fertilizer: None for the month.

Herbicide: Management will be notified before any herbicide applications.

General: Overseeded turf areas should be filled in, and ryegrass should be established. If there is frost on the turf, do not walk or drive on frost areas, or damage will occur. Watch for areas that were not filled in with ryegrass as the Bermuda goes dormant and turns brown. Apply seed and seed cover to these areas as they appear. Fertilize turf to keep good color and vigor as temperatures drop.

SHRUBS

Focus Pruning: Light pruning will continue for most plants as needed to prevent frost damage.

Replacements: Not scheduled this month. Plant replacements were completed last month.

General: Limit shrub pruning for the next couple of months to minimize frost damage to plants. If damage occurs, do not remove damaged foliage at this time. Do not plant frost-sensitive plants until March.

TREES

Scheduled Pruning: No tree pruning is scheduled.

HIGHLIGHTS

Notes: December is the month when there is a chance of significant cold weather. There is a good chance that there could be freezing temperatures and frost related damage to sensitive plants.
