



TURF

Mowing: Mowing will be done weekly to maintain healthy turf. Once Bermuda grass goes dormant, we will mow as needed.

Fertilizer: No applications are scheduled this month.

Herbicide: A request has been submitted to treat nutsedge and broadleaf weeds on the property.

General: Turf areas will be changing from the Summer Bermuda to Winter ryegrass. No Overseeding for the property this year.



SHRUBS

Focus Pruning: With cooler temperatures, plant heights on bougainvillea and Tecoma will be reduced. Sun damaged foliage will be removed on plants impacted by summer stress. Any "coverings" (mesh cloth) from plants/trees will be removed.

Replacements: A job walk is scheduled this month to identify plants that require replacement.

General: This is a good time to do any heavy pruning that may need to be done on shrubs that are overgrown. It is an ideal time for landscape planting projects. Fertilize shrubs to help them recover from summer damage.



TREES

Scheduled Pruning: No tree pruning is scheduled this month.

HIGHLIGHTS

Notes: October is an ideal time for landscapes in the Coachella Valley. Temperatures are mild. This is the time of change when we change from the survival mode of Summer to Fall planting season.
