



TURF

Mowing: Mowing will be completed at 1" as needed due to dormant Bermuda grass.

Fertilizer: Granular fertilizer will be applied depending on the weather. Bermuda turf is still in a dormancy period.

Herbicide: No application is scheduled this month.

General: Turf areas will begin to transition from ryegrass to bermudagrass as it heats up. Expect to see some stressed areas. Increase irrigation as needed. Apply herbicide to nutsedge as it appears. Fertilize turf to help facilitate Bermuda growth.

SHRUBS

Focus Pruning: Natural pruning will continue for most shrubs during normal rotation.

Replacements: Will be done per HOA approval.

General: Shrubs will be growing rapidly. Prune to control growth. April is the last chance to perform heavy pruning before the possibility of consistent high temperatures. This is the last good month for new plantings before summer.

TREES

Scheduled Pruning: No trimming is scheduled this month.

Notes: April is the beginning of transition to the Summer Season in The Coachella Valley.
