



TURF

Mowing: Mowing will be completed on a weekly basis at a height of 1.5" and will remain at that height for the rest of the month.

Fertilizer: None for the month. Bermuda grass is dormant.

Herbicide: Spot spraying will be performed for desert scapes and planters to continue with weed control with HOA approval only.

General: Turf areas may require more water as the weather warms. Pre-emergent herbicides should be applied at this time to prevent Spring weeds.



SHRUBS

Focus Pruning: Pruning will continue for shrubs through regular maintenance rotation.

Replacements: There are no replacements scheduled this month.

General: Frost-damaged foliage can be removed when no chance of frost is in the weather forecast. Watch for pests on new growth and treat if necessary.



TREES

Scheduled Pruning: Waiting for tree pruning to schedule the spraying of Olive trees to prevent fruiting. A request will be sent to HOA manager for approval to do the spray application on Olive trees.

HIGHLIGHTS

Notes: February is the last month when there are potential freezing temperatures. Spring season in the landscape usually begins in the later part of this month. Expect rapid growth as temperatures increase.
