



TURF

Mowing: Bermuda grass will be entering dormancy due to the colder weather. Mowing will be completed bi-weekly at a height of 1.5".

Fertilizer: Not scheduled due to the transition of turf.

Herbicide: A request will be submitted to treat the recent weed growth caused by the rainfall last weeks.

General: Turf will be growing slowly. Expect to see some dormant Bermuda if there are freezing temperatures. Do not walk or drive on turf where frost is present. Fertilize to keep the dark green color.



SHRUBS

Focus Pruning: Light natural pruning will continue for most plant material according to landscape maintenance rotation.

Replacements: Not scheduled this month.

General: Limit shrub pruning this month. If foliage is damaged by frost do not remove damage until next month. Roses (non-shrub) should be pruned. Hold off on new plantings of frost-sensitive plants.



TREES

Scheduled Pruning: Not scheduled this month.

HIGHLIGHTS

Notes: January is the coldest month of the year. Freezing temperatures are possible all this month. Irrigation should be at a minimum this month.
