



TURF

Mowing: Mowing will be completed at a height of 1".

Fertilizer: An application of 9-9-9 fertilizer will be applied in the first week of July in sunny areas only. Bermuda grass will not grow in shady areas.

Herbicide: Not scheduled this month.

General: Turf should be fully transitioned to Bermuda. Apply herbicides to nutsedge or broadleaf weeds as they appear. Shady areas may look bad as the summer progresses. Bermuda does not grow well in shade.

SHRUBS

Focus Pruning: Light pruning will be done to Carissas, Xylosmas, Lygustrums, Bougainvilleas, hedges, and vines.

Replacements: Will be done per HOA approval.

General: Shrubs may experience sun damage. Do not remove damaged foliage until temperatures cool in a couple of months. Limit new plantings at this time.



TREES

Scheduled Pruning: Not scheduled this month.

HIGHLIGHTS

Notes: July is the hottest month of the Summer. Extreme heat takes its toll on landscapes and landscape workers. Irrigation needs will be at the highest levels of the year, and many sensitive plants may be damaged even with adequate water during high temperatures.
